It is of bold and modern design with a classical feeling to it, equipped with the best sound systems in the world. A feeling of purity and spaciousness permeates the entire space, following the example of which are designed and selected beautiful neutral-colored furniture pieces.

In collaboration with **Luxury Sound**, an award-winning company, **Paul Regler** (CEO of Formvision) and **Milica Gruban** (Head luxury Architect and Co-founder of Luxury Department of Formvision) have designed a set of speakers and a new kitchen in cooperation with **Covet Group** from Portugal. These designs can be seen in the project of The Monaco Flat in their full glory, fitting in perfectly with the rest of Boca do Lobo's Symphony Collection furniture line. The speakers, apart from exceptional audio, contribute to the undeniable elegance of the rooms.



Cast in gold and black marble, the kitchen is clearly the most remarkable room of the flat. This bespoke creation is of futuristic parametric design, using the lines of the automotive industry and exuding luxury. The aesthetically pleasing background is made of brass tubes with 24k gold polish, providing a royal look. It acts as a curtain wall, adding to the desired dynamics of the space and creating a continuous line to the simpler living room.





The grace of the living room lies in the delicate art pieces of **Danijela Gruban's Entropy collection**, as well as the **Symphony floorstanding speakers**, the physical embodiments of the harmony that flows through the entire building.



The staircase makes a connection to the gallery with the atmosphere of relaxation. It is the perfect place to clear your mind and enjoy the clear interior, read a book or have coffee. The stone wall gives a certain warmth and provides a touch of nature in relation to the all-white furniture.

The usage of gold and white is best seen in the bedroom, where the color white is used to both calm down and bring out the nature of the lavish golden details. It is just the place for resting and enjoying the displayed artworks, as well as enjoying premium audio and aesthetics.



To divide the bedroom from the bathroom, we used glass instead of a regular wall. In this way, the spatial proportions are flawlessly balanced and the openness of the clear space is kept. The gleam illuminating the bedroom stems from the bathroom furniture pieces, garnished in precious materials and milky white marble. The look of the bathroom is strikingly reminiscent of milk and honey, a sweet and perfectly poised combination, timelessly adored.
